Foróige, West Iveragh Youth Service is a dynamic and flexible service that works to meet the every changing needs of young people, in particular those young people most at risk of not meeting their fullest potential. This will be achieved through programmes that build confidence, creativity, resilience, relationships, cultural respect, life skills and a sense of belonging, in partnership with young people and their community. The West Iveragh Youth Service is funded by the Department of Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth. It is a UBU compliant service supported by Kerry Education and Training Board (Kerry ETB). The project is a newly funded targeted project, which aims to develop services in ETB areas, where a gap in service provision has been identified, specifically for young people ages 10-24 years who have identified needs additional to the general population. The aim of the service is to give young people an opportunity to overcome adversity and reach their full potential in a safe and supportive environment.
