



Overview:

The YHDPP offers support for 16-24 year olds who are experiencing homelessness, or are at risk of homeless.

Those aged 18-24 can be offered accommodation, those under 18 are referred to statutory services for accommodation. ***

Support and referrals are offered around areas such as education, training and employment, physical health, mental health, addiction, accommodation, recreational activities, harm reduction, family relationships and any other support needs identified by the young person. Referrals to other services include referral to other accommodation providers, addiction treatment centres, counselling, training providers, HSE Adult Homeless Integrated Team.

Support is offered on a one-to-one basis, detached key-working, and street work.
