



Overview:

The Extension Day Service is a drop-in facility for young people aged 16 to 25 who are accessing homeless services in Dublin. It provides a supportive environment for this vulnerable cohort during the day. It offers advice, information and advocacy to enable them to access appropriate supports, address the causes of their homelessness and achieve independence.

The PETE Project delivers education/training to young people aged 16 years and over to help them gain the skills and confidence necessary to access existing pathways to mainstream training, education and employment.

Block 4 (STA) provides temporary accommodation for young homeless adults who are deemed hard-to-reach. It provides individualized support, focusing on challenges, goals and a move to stable, long-term accommodation.
